

PRIVACY POLICY

This page describes how to manage your site in relation to the processing of personal information of the users who consult it.

This is an information that is also made pursuant to art. 13 of Legislative Decree no. 196/2003 - Personal Data Protection Code for those who interact with Resett Engineering web services, accessible by telematic address starting at: <http://www.resett.net> corresponding to the homepage of the site u of the company.

The information is only made for the site of Resett Engineering and not for any other websites that may be consulted by the user through links.

The information is also inspired by Recommendation n. 2/2001 that the European Data Protection Authorities, gathered in the Group established by art. Article 29 of Directive 95/46 / EC, adopted May 17, 2001 to identify some minimum requirements for the collection of personal data online, and in particular the modalities, times and nature of the information that processors have to provide to users when they connect to web pages, independently from the purposes of the link.

THE "TITLE" OF TREATMENT

Following the consultation of this site, data relating to identified persons or identifiable identities may be processed.

The "holder" of their treatment is Resett Engineering, based at Via Balbo 35, 60044 Fabriano Ancona Italy.

DATA PROCESSING PLACE

The processing of the web services of this site takes place at the aforesaid headquarters of the Company and its libel and is handled only by personnel responsible for the treatment, or from any occasional service of maintenance and by potential agents appointed as "External Treatment Officers" with a special document.

No data deriving from the web service is communicated or used.

Personal information provided by users submitting requests for information (Cd-roms, publications, newsletters, answers to questions, etc.) are used solely to perform the requested service or service and are communicated to third parties in the sole case this is necessary (shipping and sending services).

TYPES OF TREATED DATA

Navigation data:

Computer systems and software procedures for the operation of this website acquire, during their normal operation, certain personal data whose transmission is implied in the use of Internet communication protocols.

These are information that is not collected to be associated with relevant stakeholders but which by their very nature could, through elaborations and associations with data held by third parties, allow users to be well-informed.

This category of data includes the IP addresses or domain names of the computers used by the users that connect to the site, the URI notation addresses (Uniform Resource Identifier) of the required resources, the time of the request, the method used in submitting server request, response size, numeric code indicating the status of the server response (good, error, etc.) and other parameters related to the operating system and the user's computer environment.

This data is used only to obtain anonymous statistical information on the use of the site and to check its proper functioning and are deleted immediately after processing. The data could be used for the detection of liability in the event of hypothetical cybercrime for damage to the site: save this eventuality, state of the web contact data does not persist for more than seven days.

Data voluntarily provided by the user:

The optional, explicit and voluntary sending of e-mail to the addresses indicated or through forms to be filled in on this site involves the subsequent acquisition of the address of the sender, necessary to meet the requests as well as any other personal data included in the letter or forms.

Specifies that summary information will be progressively reported or displayed on site pages tailored for particular on-demand services.

COOKIES POLICY

What are they and what they are:

cookies are the small ones stored on your computer's hard disk and serve to provide services and / or information.

There are two types of cookies: technical and protocols.

Technical cookies, which are used for the normal browsing experience on the site, as well as for improving the service, feature session cookies, analytics and functionality. Session cookies ensure normal navigation and enjoyment of the web; cookies analytics are used to gather information in anonymous and aggregated form,

how many users visit the site; Feature cookies allow the user to navigate according to a set of selected criteria (such as the language) to improve the service rendered to them.

Projection cookies, on the other hand, are used to outline the user's interests and interests so as to target them in a manner and with the aim of targeting advertisements, even by third parties.

It is, however, noteworthy that deactivating cookies could disable some site features. In any case, even disabling all cookies, the browser will continue to store a small amount of information needed for the basic functionality of the site.

OPTIONAL DATA CONFIDENTIAL

Apart from the specificity of the navigation data, the user is free to provide the personal data contained in the application forms to Resett Engineering or otherwise indicated in contacts with the company in order to solicit the sending of information material or other communications.

Failure to do so may result in the impossibility of obtaining what is required.

TREATMENT MODES

Personal data is handled with automated tools for the time strictly necessary to achieve the purposes for which they were collected.

Specifies that security measures are being taken to prevent data loss, misuse or incorrect use, and unauthorized access.

RIGHTS OF THE INTERESTED PARTIES

Subjects to whom personal data are referenced have the right at any time to obtain confirmation of the existence or not of the same data and to know the content and origin of actual meat, or to request the integration or updating thereof, or retention (Article 7 of Legislative Decree 196/2003).

Under the same article you have the right to request the cancellation, transformation into anonymous form or the blocking of the data processed in violation of the law, and to oppose in any case, for legitimate reasons, their treatment.
